

What is **CHILD ABUSE?**

It is any mistreatment of a child that results in harm or injury.

Child abuse includes:

PHYSICAL ABUSE

For example, purposely hurting a child by hitting, biting or shaking

EMOTIONAL ABUSE

For example, crushing a child's spirit with threats or put-downs

SEXUAL ABUSE

For example, sexual contact with a child,; using a child for sexual films or prostitution; obscene language

NEGLECT

For example, failing to provide for a child's emotional needs (love, attention, etc.) or physical needs (food, clothing, shelter, etc.); failing to offer supervision

WHAT YOU CAN DO
